as follows:

厂 (h): Houli (hòulǐ), Horse Ranch

니 (j): Jiji (jíjí), Jiji Train Station

く (q): Qishan (qíshān), Banana

↑ (x): Xinpu (xīnpŭ), Persimmon Cake

里 (zh): Zhanghua (zhānghuà), Big Buddha

彳 (ch): Chishang (chíshàng), Rice

ア (sh): Shimen (shímén), Laomei Green Reef

☐ (r): Ruisui (ruìsuì), Roselle

7 (z): Zuozhen (zuŏzhèn), Caoshan Moon World

ち (c): Citong (citóng), Garlic.
