



New Year's Greeting Postage Stamps (Issue of 2025)

To welcome the New Year, Chunghwa Post has issued a set of two New Year stamps and a souvenir sheet. The design is based on the theme: “welcoming the new year with great vitality,” using a Chinese idiom that translates directly as “with the spirit of the dragon horse.” The details are as follows:

1. **NT\$6 stamp:** The red horse symbolizes joy and prosperity, and wishes for a bright future and success in the new year.
2. **NT\$13 stamp:** The white horse symbolizes perseverance and strength, and wishes for taking the lead in the new year and striving for continuous self-improvement.
3. **NT\$15 souvenir sheet:** The red horse soars into the clouds, leaping magnificently with great momentum. The image symbolizes the spirit of a dashing and galloping robust horse in the coming new year.



To increase the joy of philatelists, Chunghwa Post has released “New Year’s Greeting Postage Stamps (Issue of 2025) Uncut Press Sheets” on the same date that the stamps were released. A special collectible tube contains the following: one uncut press sheet comprising two panes of 20 NT\$6 stamps, another uncut press sheet with the same for the NT\$13 stamps, an uncut press sheet featuring 9 souvenir sheets, and a certificate of authenticity. The press sheets’ margins retain marks from the printing process, including traffic lights and indicators for cutting. Press sheets such as these have been successively issued by Chunghwa Post since 2009 and are highly valued by collectors. This item is not apply to any discount measures.
