

為闡揚古畫之美，本公司特以國立故宮博物院典藏之「清張若靄畫墨妙珠林(卯)冊」為主題，分次發行系列郵票 4 套，首套「秋」含立秋、處暑、白露、秋分、寒露、霜降 6 枚郵票圖案，面值均為 8 元，以聯刷方式印製，每枚郵票長邊中間有異形齒孔。

《墨妙珠林》為清乾隆時期的巨幅冊頁集，全套共有 12 冊，以地支編號，卯冊為張若靄所繪二十四節氣圖，其詮釋節氣的方式以山水圖案為主軸，有透過古代大家風格表現當令氣候，或有點綴應時的風俗活動、自然界動植物生態，呈現不同節氣景物的變化。



To present the beauty of ancient Chinese paintings, Chunghwa Post has planned a series of four sets of stamps drawn from the *Ink Marvels from a Forest of Pearls (IV)* by Zhang Ruai of the Qing dynasty, a work held in the National Palace Museum. The first set contains six stamps, each valued at NT\$ 8, depicting autumn with its six solar terms: Beginning of Autumn, End of Heat, White Dew, Autumnal Equinox, Cold Dew, and First Frost. The six stamps are in a se-tenant block and the shaped perforations are at the center of the long sides of the stamps.



The *Ink Marvels from a Forest of Pearls* is a collection of large paintings gathered into twelve albums in the time of the Qianlong Emperor. The albums are named after the Twelve Terrestrial Branches, the fourth album being entrusted to Zhang Ruai, who painted the 24 solar terms and expressed each term by landscape painting. The paintings use the styles of the ancient masters to express the climate, show customary activities and the state of the natural world, and depict the variations proper to the given term.
