為闡揚書法之美，本公司特以國立故宮博物院典藏之宋蘇軾〈書前赤壁賦〉卷為主題，分次發行系列郵票 3 套，上輯郵票 1 套 5 枚，面值均為 8 元，以聯刷方式印製。

蘇軾，字子瞻，號東坡居士，四川眉山人，兼善詩文、繪畫、書法，其文學地位崇高，為北宋四大書家之一。〈書前赤壁賦〉為現今僅存的蘇軾〈赤壁賦〉手蹟，筆墨豐潤沉穩，抒發對人生的體悟，為千古傳誦的文學名作。

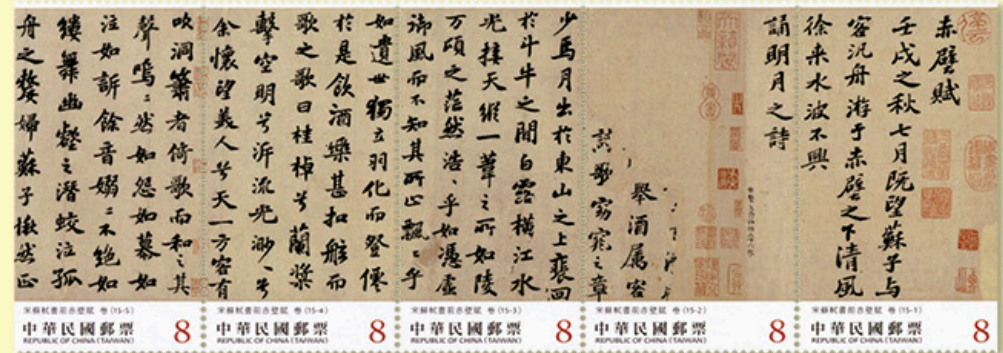
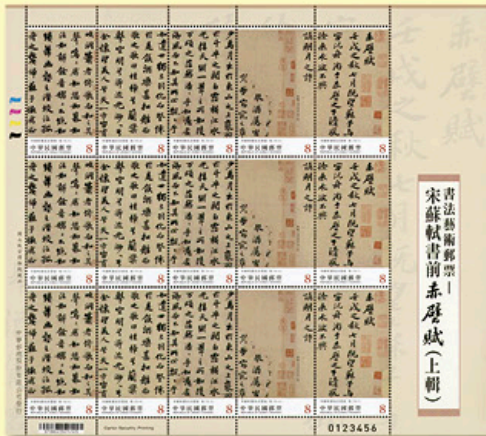

In praise of the beauty of calligraphy, Chunghwa Post has chosen “Former Ode on the Red Cliff” by the Song dynasty poet-artist, Su Shi. This scroll is held in the National Palace Museum. Chunghwa Post has planned to present it in three sets. The first set has five se-tenant stamps with each stamp valued at NT\$8.

Su Shi, courtesy name Zizhan, sobriquet The Hermit of Dongpo, came from Meishan in Sichuan. He was equally good at poetry, painting and calligraphy and holds a high place in literature, acclaimed as one of the four great calligraphers of the Northern Song dynasty. The scroll with the Ode is one of the few extant works in his own hand. The brushstrokes are full-bodied yet sedate, showing his understanding of human life. The work is a classic piece of literature having proven its value for nearly a thousand years.
