新 郵 預 告

新年郵票(115 年版)

民國 116 年歲次丁未，生肖屬羊。為迎接新年來臨，本公司續規劃於 115 年 12 月 1 日發行「新年郵票(115 年版)」1 套 2 枚及小全張 1 張。

本套郵票圖案以「吉羊帶福慶新年」為設計概念，值年生肖羊悠遊於繁花碩果間，象徵新年豐收在望，共創璀璨未來，圖案簡介如下：

- 一、 面值 6 元郵票：「吉羊如意」，玄羊穿梭於富貴子中，傳達新年興旺、萬事亨通，寓意財富積累，蒸蒸日上。
- 二、 面值 13 元郵票：「喜氣洋洋」，祥羊悠遊於山茶花海，傳遞福祿安康、繁榮昌盛，象徵喜慶吉祥，收成豐稔。
- 三、 面值 15 元小全張：「三羊開泰」，背景融合歲寒三友堅韌意象，映照羊年厚土載物的深蘊，喻示大地回春、生機勃發，願新年福澤綿長，步步高升。

為增添集郵樂趣，同日發售「新年郵票(115 年版)印刷全張」郵品，以專用典藏圓筒收納，內含未裁切之面值 6 元、13 元郵票全張(20 枚)各 2 張、小全張印刷全張(9 小張)1 張及證書 1 份，紙邊皆保留印製過程所標記之色標、裁切線等記號，內容豐富，本項郵品自 98 年起系列發行，極具收藏價值。

本套郵票圖案係獲得本公司舉辦第 5 輪第 6 次生肖郵票甄選活動首獎本質設計顧問有限公司作品，由卡登實業股份有限公司以彩色平版印製。配合郵票發行，特印製首日封、貼票卡、護票卡及活頁集郵卡各 1 批，於 115 年 11 月 27 日開始發售；另製作預銷首日戳低值封、套票封及小全張封，於 12 月 1 日郵票發行當天出售，歡迎選購。其他詳情請參閱本公司印發之集郵報導或今日郵政月刊。

New Year's Greeting Postage Stamps (Issue of 2026)

The year 2027 is the Year of the Goat and the 44th year in the traditional Chinese cycle of 60 years. On December 1, 2026, to celebrate the coming new year, Chunghwa Post is releasing a set of two “New Year's Greeting Postage Stamps (Issue of 2026),” along with a souvenir sheet.

The stamps are designed around the concept of “the auspicious goats bringing good fortune to celebrate the new year.” In the Year of the Goat, the goats wander freely among flowers and fruits, symbolizing a year of bountiful harvests and the promise of creating a brilliant future together. The designs of the stamps follow:

1. NT\$6 stamp: “Goat of Good Fortune,” a dark goat weaves through clusters of coral ardisia, conveying wishes for a prosperous new year and for smoothly attaining success in all endeavors. The image symbolizes prosperity and the steady accumulation of wealth.
2. NT\$13 stamp: “Joy and Abundance,” an auspicious goat wanders leisurely through a sea of camellia blossoms, conveying blessings of good fortune, health, and prosperity. The image symbolizes celebration, auspiciousness, and a bountiful harvest.
3. NT\$15 souvenir sheet: “Three Goats Bring Prosperity,” the background incorporates imagery of the resilient “Three Friends of Winter.” These symbolize the steadfastness and Mother-Earth-like nurturing that characterize

the Year of the Goat. The image conveys the message of spring's return and the flourishing of new life, expressing wishes for enduring blessings and burgeoning success in the new year.

To increase the fun for philatelists, Chunghwa Post is also releasing “New Year’s Greeting Postage Stamps (Issue of 2026) Uncut Press Sheets” on the same date that the stamps are released. A special collectible tube contains the following: one uncut press sheet comprising two 20-stamp sheets of the NT\$6 stamps, another uncut press sheet with the same for the NT\$13 stamps, an uncut press sheet featuring 9 souvenir sheets, and a certificate of authenticity. The press sheets’ margins retain marks from the printing process, including traffic lights and indicators for cutting. Press sheets such as these have been successively issued by Chunghwa Post since 2009 and are highly valued by collectors.

The stamps were designed by Benzhi Design Consultant Co., Ltd., the winner of Chunghwa Post’s sixth iteration of the fifth round of open competition for designers of New Year’s Greeting Postage Stamps, and printed by Cardon Enterprise Co., Ltd. in color offset. By-issues include a first day cover, folders with or without crystal mounts, and a loose-leaf album page, all be available on November 27, 2026. Pre-cancelled FDCs with either one NT\$6-denominated stamp, a full set of stamps, or a souvenir sheet will go on sale on December 1, 2026, the date of issuance of the stamps.
