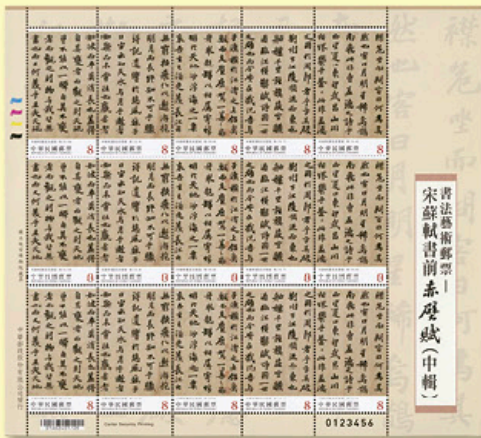

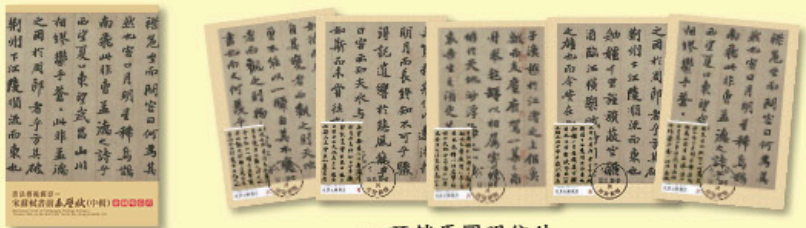
繼 113 年 9 月 25 日發行「書法藝術郵票 — 宋蘇軾書前赤壁賦（上輯）」，本公司續以國立故宮博物院典藏之宋蘇軾〈書前赤壁賦〉卷為主題，發行中輯郵票 1 套 5 枚，面值均為 8 元，以聯刷方式印製。

宋神宗元豐五年（1082 年）蘇軾泛舟遊赤壁，後來作前後兩篇〈赤壁賦〉，文字優美，深富哲理，為千古傳誦的文學名作。〈書前赤壁賦〉為現今僅存的蘇軾〈赤壁賦〉手蹟，筆墨豐潤沉穩，抒發對人生的體悟。

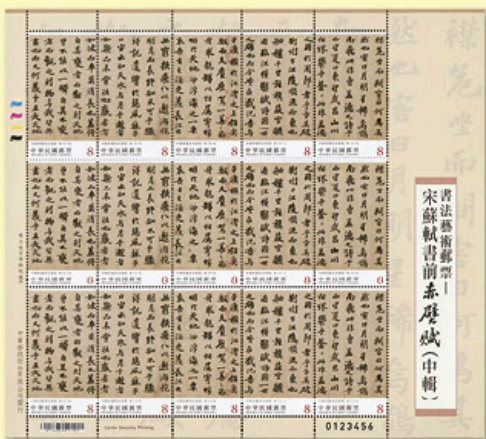

Following the first set of stamps depicting “Former Ode on the Red Cliff,” a work by Su Shi of the Song dynasty and is held in the National Palace Museum, issued on September 25, 2024, Chunghwa Post has issued the second set of five se-tenant stamps, each valued at NT\$8.

In 1082, Su Shi traveled by boat to the Red Cliff, after which he composed both a former and latter “Ode on the Red Cliff.” Using elegant and profound words, the work is a classic piece of literature having proven its value for nearly a thousand years. The scroll with the Ode is one of the few extant works in his own hand. The brushstrokes are full-bodied yet sedate, showing his understanding of human life.
