國民法官新制實施紀念郵票小全張

國民法官制度將於 112 年 1 月 1 日正式施行,為我國司法史上首次由國民與職業法官共同審判的制度,深具時代意義,本公司為誌紀念,特規劃小全張 1 張,內含面值 28 元郵票 1 枚,預定於 112 年 1 月 3 日發行。

郵票以國民法官法庭為主題,版銘部分為國定古蹟司法大廈圖案。國民 法官法庭由 6 名國民法官與 3 名職業法官共同組成,負責審理重大刑 事案件,年滿 23 歲以上的國民,皆有機會被抽選為國民法官,藉由積 極參與、提供多元觀點,讓司法更貼近民眾想法,提升司法的透明度, 加深國民對司法的理解與信賴。

本套郵票由大觀視覺顧問股份有限公司設計,卡登實業股份有限公司 以彩色平版印製。配合郵票發行,特印製首日封、貼票卡、護票卡、明 信片及活頁集郵卡各1批,於111年12月29日開始發售;另製作預 銷首日戳小全張封於112年1月3日郵票發行當天出售,歡迎選購。 其他詳情,請參閱本公司印行之集郵報導或今日郵政月刊。

The Implementation of Citizen Judges System Commemorative Souvenir Sheet

The Citizen Judges System will formally go into effect on January 1, 2023, putting citizen and professional judges on the same trial panels for the first time in the nation's history. The change carries deep historical significance. To commemorate this event, Chunghwa Post is specially releasing a souvenir sheet with one stamp of a face value of NT\$28 and will be released on January 3, 2023.

The stamp features a court with citizen judges, and the marginal inscription of the souvenir sheet features the Judicial Office Building in Taipei, which is a national heritage site. Under this new system, judicial panels responsible for reaching verdicts for major criminal cases will consist of six citizen judges and three professional judges. Citizens who are at least 23 years of age will be eligible to serve. Through their active participation and diverse perspectives, the citizens on these panels will bring the judiciary closer in line with popular thinking and raise transparency, increasing understanding of the judiciary and faith in its reliability.

The souvenir sheet was designed by Delta Design Corporation and printed by Cardon Enterprise Co., Ltd. in color offset. By-issues include a first-day cover, folders with and without crystal mounts, a postal card, and a loose-leaf album page to be sold on December 29, 2022. A pre-cancelled FDC with a souvenir sheet will go on sale on January 3, 2023, the stamp's date of
