繼113年11月20日發行「書法藝術郵票-宋蘇軾書前赤壁賦（中輯）」，本公司續以國立故宮博物院典藏之宋蘇軾〈書前赤壁賦〉卷為主題，發行下輯郵票1套5枚，面值均為8元，以聯刷方式印製。

〈書前赤壁賦〉為現今僅存的蘇軾〈赤壁賦〉手蹟，筆墨豐潤沉穩，集文學與藝術創作於一體。賦中描繪神宗元豐五年（1082年），蘇軾與友人乘舟遊覽黃州城外赤鼻磯，遙想三國時代孫權破曹軍的赤壁之戰，抒發對人生的體悟。

配合郵票發行，特推出「書法藝術郵票－宋蘇軾書前赤壁賦珍藏摺」，完整收錄上、中、下輯15枚郵票，採聯刷設計，全長52公分，極具收藏價值。

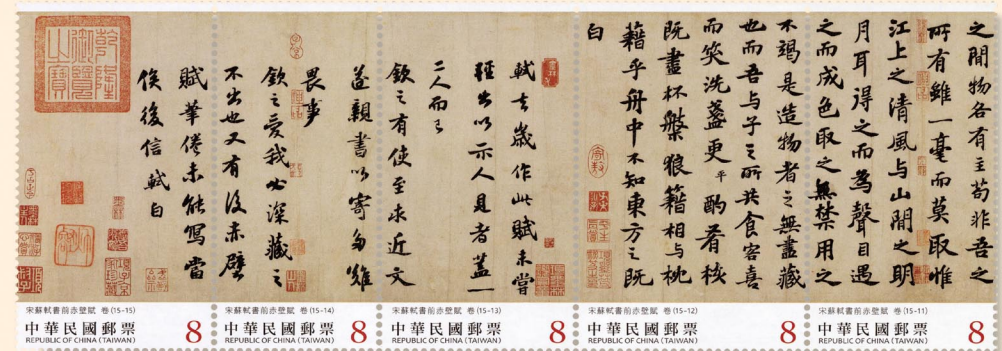
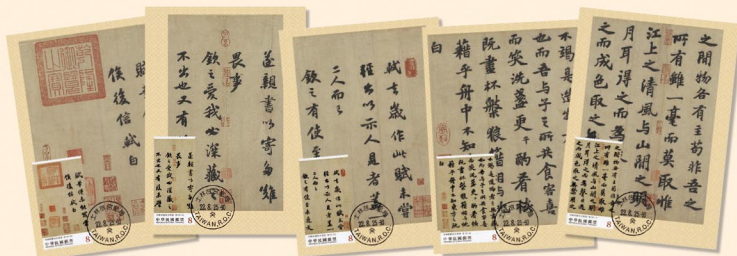
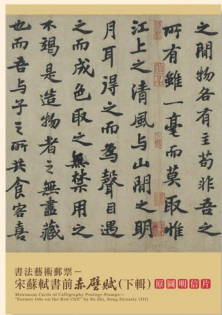

Following the second set of stamps depicting “Former Ode on the Red Cliff,” a work by Su Shi of the Song dynasty and is held in the National Palace Museum, issued on November 20, 2024, Chunghwa Post has issued the third set of five se-tenant stamps, each valued at NT\$8.

“Former Ode on the Red Cliff” is the only surviving work of Su Shi’s “Ode on the Red Cliff” Calligraphy. The brushstrokes are full-bodied yet sedate. The work combines literature with artistic creation. In 1082, he took a boat excursion with friends to the Red Cliff. He recalled the Battle of the Red Cliff that Sun Quan attacked Cao Cao’s forces during the Three Kingdoms period, and showed his understanding of human life.

A stamp collection containing the first, second and third sets of the postage stamps has been released along with the stamps. The design with a 52-centimeter-long horizontal se-tenant strip of fifteen, the collection is worth collecting.
