PHILAKOREA 2025 World Stamp Exhibition is to be held in Korea from September 17 to 21, 2025. To mark its participation, Chunghwa Post has issued a commemorative envelope with 7,500 pieces in total. The envelopes without stamps are available beginning September 15, 2025 while the ones with stamps each affixed with one Taiwan Scenery Postage Stamps — Taipei City: Zhuzihu Calla Lily Festival issued on October 9, 2024 and pre-cancelled with a first-day postmark and a commemorative cachet, beginning September 17, 2025. These envelopes can be purchased at the main post offices listed below, philatelic centers, and the Postal Museum, as well as on line at <https://stamp.post.gov.tw>. Main post offices: Taipei, Keelung, Banqiao, Sanchong, Yilan, Taoyuan, Hsinchu, Miaoli, Taichung, Nantou, Changhua, Yunlin, Chiayi, Tainan, Kaohsiung, Pingtung, Taitung, Hualien and Penghu.

A commemorative cachet is available on September 17, 2025 at the Postal Museum and the Taipei Beimen Post Office, as well as 36 other post office branches that operate business for long-term philatelic subscribers.
