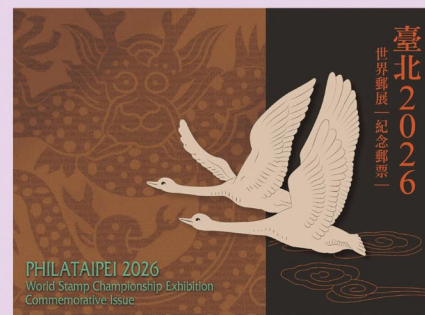

「臺北2026世界郵展」於115年11月20日至25日假台北世界貿易中心展覽一館舉行，郵展主題為「創新∞永續」，為誌郵展盛事，本公司特以「龍騰創新、飛雁永續」為設計理念，發行郵票1套2枚及小全張1張。本組郵票採票中票形式設計，重新詮釋海關一次雲龍郵票（簡稱大龍票）及飛雁圖無面值票，象徵中華郵政悠久歷史與持續創新精神。各郵票圖案簡介如下：

- 一、面值17元郵票：以大龍票三分銀為主題，龍象徵力量及智慧，寓意變革與生命力，整體設計傳達中華郵政在歷史積累上持續創新發展。
- 二、面值28元郵票：以飛雁圖無面值郵票為主題，飛雁蘊含團結與堅韌，象徵傳遞及前行，整體設計體現中華郵政持續邁進，永續發展的理念。
- 三、小全張：內含面值17元及28元郵票各1枚，郵票圖案與前2枚相同，惟以彩色平版精印，版銘以「臺北2026世界郵展」LOGO為主要視覺元素。

為增添集郵趣味，特別製作「臺北2026世界郵展紀念郵票」珍稀版、珍藏版（銀色款）及珍藏版（金色款）3款限量專屬贈品以彩色平版精印，其中珍藏版（銀色款）及（金色款）首度導入區塊鏈技術，推出數位郵票典藏版，讓集郵愛好者享有實體與數位雙重收藏體驗。

配合「臺北2026世界郵展」首日「郵政日」主題，郵票發行日同時推出精美郵摺1款，內含17元及28元郵票各1枚、小全張1張，並附限量版專屬贈品「臺北2026世界郵展紀念郵票」珍藏版（銀色款）1張，掃描版銘 QR Code 即可鑄造專屬數位典藏版，數位典藏版共有2款圖案，每本隨機贈送1款。郵摺限量發行5,000本，極具收藏紀念意義。

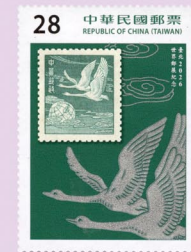

The PHILATAIPEI 2026 World Stamp Championship Exhibition is held on November 20-25, 2026, at Exhibition Hall 1 of the Taipei World Trade Center. The theme of the exhibition is “Innovation and Sustainability.” To commemorate this major philatelic event, a set of two stamps and a souvenir sheet with the theme of “soaring dragons of innovation, flying geese of sustainability” have been issued. Featuring stamp-within-a-stamp designs, the stamps reinterpret two iconic stamps: the 1st Customs Dragon Issue (the Large Dragon Stamp) and a Flying Geese Stamp bearing no face value. These symbolize Chunghwa Post’s long history and its ongoing spirit of innovation. The stamps are described below:

1. The NT\$17 stamp: The stamp features a 3-candarin Large Dragon Stamp. The dragon symbolizes strength and wisdom, conveying transformation and vitality. The overall design expresses Chunghwa Post’s commitment to continuing innovations and to development built upon its historical legacy.
2. The NT\$28 stamp: The stamp features a Flying Geese Stamp bearing no face value. The flying geese embody unity and resilience, symbolizing transmission of mail and forward progress. The overall design reflects Chunghwa Post’s commitment to continual advancement and to the principle of sustainable development.
3. The souvenir sheet: It contains NT\$17 and NT\$28 stamps featuring the same designs as the previous two, printed in color offset with fine detail. The inscription design uses the PHILATAIPEI 2026 World Stamp Championship Exhibition logo as its main visual element.

To enhance the enjoyment of stamp collecting, three exclusive limited-edition gifts printed in color offset with fine detail have been specially released for the PHILATAIPEI 2026 World Stamp Championship Exhibition Commemorative Issue: the Rare Edition, the Limited Edition (Silver Version), and the Limited Edition (Gold Version). The Limited Editions (Silver and Gold Versions) incorporate blockchain technology for the first time, launching digital collectible editions that allow philatelists to enjoy the dual-collection experiences, both physical and digital.

The theme of the first day of PHILATAIPEI 2026 World Stamp Championship Exhibition is Post Day. On the same day as the stamp issuance, a beautiful stamp folio is launched, containing one NT\$17 stamp, one NT\$28 stamp, and one souvenir sheet. It also includes an exclusive limited-edition gift: a PHILATAIPEI 2026 World Stamp Championship

Exhibition Commemorative Issue Limited Edition (Silver Version). Consumers can scan the QR Code on the inscription to claim an exclusive digital collectible edition. The digital collectible editions come in two different designs, and collectors will receive one design at random upon purchase. The stamp folio is limited to 5,000 copies, making it highly valuable for collecting.

The PHILATAIPEI 2026 World Stamp Championship Exhibition is held from November 20 to 25, 2026, at the Taipei World Trade Center Exhibition Hall 1. Chunghwa Post has issued a postage label designed around *Depictions of Blooms, Album Four, Tree Peonies 7* by Qian Weicheng of the Qing dynasty, a work held in the National Palace Museum. On the lower left corner of each label is a serial number with two English letters (which signify the roll number) and four Arabic numerals. There is a total of 800 rolls with 1,000 labels each.

The postage label will be available on November 20, 2026 in postage label vending machines at the following branches: Keelung Aisan Rd., Taichung Minqyuan Rd., Tainan Chenggong Rd., Chiayi Yushan, Zhubei, Yuanlin, Hualien Guoan, Fongshan, Yilan Zhongshan Rd., Taoyuan Chenggong Rd., Longtan, Sanchong Zhongshan Rd., Linkou, Hsinchu Wuchang St., Zhudong, Douliou Xiping Rd., Xinxing, and Pingtung Minsheng Rd. Those which installed at Taipei Beimen, Taipei Daan, Zhongli Neili, and Yangmei will be moved to the venue during the session for customers’ convenience.
